- Mary Rose Mission now serving around 100 guests. Unused food provided by St. Timothy is now returned to St. Timothy. Next St. Tim dinner date is August 28.

- SVdP – would benefit from additional members. Several low income housing units are closing increasing difficulty for assisting clients in finding new housing. There is an increase in difficult cases with ongoing needs.
- Yard Sale netted \$3771 to be donated to Ed Colina Foundation.
- Outreach rally – added 10 additional volunteers.
- \*School Supply Drive - 1,323 items sent to City Heights and BeConcerned
- Grants - October 15-16 Catholic Charities Grant, followed by Brighton Center
- Election of Officers - Co-Chair Christie Dunaway, Second Chair-Rosalie Hentz, Secretary-Marta Kroger
- Right to Life - plan to for committee to educate/advocate for passage of KY 2nd Amendment
