a. Review of April20 YTD results.

b. Reviewed the still TBD approved the 20/21 budget. Per Father, the numbers won't change but may shift in how they are being captured. Very conservative approach given hard to estimate impact from COVID.

Committee Reports: No official meetings were held due to COVID-19 restrictions. Notes represent the conversations taken in course of Pastoral Council.

School:

- a. Diocese has all schools starting in August, still TBD. Goal to get as much in person educating done in possible. All teachers must be informed of contract renewal by May 15 per Diocesan regulations.
- b. 234 enrolled, including 7 more this week.
- c. Deb on Task Force with Principals to align process/regulations.
- d. Pre School and School will be merged per FlockNote message from Father.
- e. Pre School enrollment is down by nearly 1/3. From 191 to current 130. Closer to breakeven than profitable and changes in direction and structure needed to be made.

Deanery:

a. Nothing to share. Check back next month!

Education:

a. American Heritage asking for parish guidance for ministries next year, but that is dictated by Diocese. We are awaiting guidance, but currently no groups are permitted to meet.

Meeting opened with a prayer

Established quorum and approved minutes by acclamation

Mary Rose Mission: since March serving outside bagged meals only from 4pm-5pm for the foreseeable future; includes a hot meal

St Vincent de Paul: not much going on, it's opened up and they have a few things but have to be very careful; pantry is full

St Elizabeth Health Care: Cardio can will be here Mon 7/13

Garden: been harvesting a good 150-200 lbs per week, lots of peppers, zucchini, beets, cabbage, lettuce, kale and mustard greens; going to Rose Garden Mission and City Heights

Family Promise: in March the family moved into a hotel & have graduated, have a new family staying in an extended stay hotel, need microwave dinners (especially for the child) and gift cards; IHM, Union Presbyterian, and Hebron Lutheran help support out week

Pastoral Council: no report

Youth Group: haven't met, no report

Discernment: not happening this year, keeping status quo for now; school rep is on hold with everything else going on

Drive thru food drive (40 cans for Lent): had about 4,000 lbs before drive up, collected about 2500 lbs at drive up

July Grant: Rose Garden Mission - will speak at 7/25 and 7/26 Masses; service projects will have to wait until later

Yard Sale: Aug 8, we will not participate this year by unanimous decision

Back to School Drive: lists will be available at the 7/11 and 7/12 Masses and will collect items the following weekend

Mission Trip: had to be canceled to MS; working on a virtual mission trip with the Navajo Indians in three states out west, their COVID rate is higher than NY, will open to Youth Group and the school, will have Zoom learning nights; working on other activities to do

Blessing bags: will work with the school and preschool to collect as a parish, the kids will pack them

Next meeting is August 13
