## WORSHIP COMMITTEE REPORT

- Educational Program for the Fall
  - A discussion was held about the options for an alternate educational session(s) to be held this fall. The group decided on utilizing Bishop Robert Barron's The Pivotal Players, specifically Augustine and Thomas Aquinas.
  - Maureen will check on the availability of using a classroom in the school. Proposed dates are Wednesday, 11/20/24 and Wednesday, 12/11/24 from 6:00 PM to 7:30 PM. Each video is an hour and will be followed by discussion. The entire Worship Committee will attend the last session on their regularly scheduled monthly meeting night of 12/11/24. At the conclusion of the session the committee will have a shortened meeting.
  - Once the space in the school has been reserved, Elliot will prepare an announcement for the bulletin which he will submit to Lynn on Monday, 10/28/24.
- Fr. Bolte's Letter to the Worship Committee Christopher West "Made for More"
  - Deacon Steve and Fr. Bolte have had further discussions, and the result is that Fr. Bolte does not want to continue with the proposed Made for More follow-up educational sessions. The program does not address homosexuality, it only addressed heterosexual relationships.
  - Fr. Bolte is challenging our committee to appeal to that underrepresented group. We need to include everyone that attends and not pretend it is not there. If you are going to have this program you must include addressing homosexual tendencies, those experiencing same sex attraction.
  - Elliot said we need to respond to Fr. Bolte's letter. There is a concern that the mindset of some parishioners is that gay people are going to hell. If a person has same sex attraction they are going to hell.
  - We should try to educate ourselves. Eden Invitation and Courage were two resources recommended by Maureen. We should all consider reviewing the Theology of the Body Crash Course (four parts) by Fr. Mike Schmitz. Fr. Bolte has said that we could create/adapt our own program. Homosexuals should always be included with compassion. We need to be prepared with resources and look at each person holistically.
