

## St. Timothy Committee Nominations

Every year members of parish committees rotate off after serving three years and new members are selected. Members can serve a maximum of two terms. New members are neither selected by the pastor nor voted for. Our process calls for all who are nominated and accept the nomination to prayerfully discern among themselves who would be best to serve. This is done at a Sunday afternoon meeting (**May 17 at 12:45 IN SCHOOL CAFETERIA**). For each committee an alternate is also chosen in the event that a regular member cannot fulfill their term.

**The Pastoral Council** advises the pastor in all areas related to the needs and growth of the parish. Pastoral Council has 10 voting members. Six are representatives, one each from the other parish committees. One is our representative with the Diocesan Pastoral Council. The other three have roles as executive council members (chair, vice chair, and secretary). These latter three are part of the yearly discernment process. Mary Finke & Ginny Baumgarten are current members and cannot be nominated. Meets 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday at 7:00 pm. **One member is needed plus one alternate.**

**The Finance Council** advises the pastor and Pastoral Council on financial feasibility of parish activities as well as keeping an eye on the budget. It consists of six members; two members rotating off and two selected each year. Members of this committee should have some experience with working with budgets and ability to read financial spreadsheets. Brian Henson, Mark Arnett, Mark Otto, Lisa Goetz, & Trevor Rosenbaum are current members and cannot be nominated. Meets 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday at 7:00 pm. **Two members are needed plus one alternate.**

**The Worship & Adult Education Committee** oversees all our liturgies in particular our special services as well as parish adult education. A member of the Bereavement Committee, Music Ministry, and Art and Environment Committee serve on this committee. Maureen Cirillo, David Krenk, Tom Herbstreit, and Maribeth Duerstock are current members and cannot be nominated, Elliot Meiser and Nikki Davis have served one term and can be nominated. Meets 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday at 7:00 pm. **Two members needed plus one alternate.**

**The School Advisory Committee** advises the principal and pastor on the running of the school. As these members are also involved with other school committees, fundraising, and other school events; members should have students in the school. The principal picks three members and the other three are discerned on the rotating basis. Karen Ulery, Brian Henson, Lee Metzger & Tom Shriner are current members and cannot be nominated. Meets 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday at 6:00 pm. **One member is needed plus one alternate.**

**The Fun and Fellowship Committee** plans and manages the various events of our parish for fun, fellowship, and fundraising [Oktoberfest, Breakfast with Santa, Trunk-r-Treat, etc.) and is always looking for new and fun ideas. Coleman Benvie, Alex Torres, John Strassburger, Janet Davis & Colleen Brockman are current members and cannot be nominated. Meets 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday at 7:00 pm. **Three members are needed plus one alternate.**

**The Youth Education Committee** is made up of a representative of each of the youth centered ministries of the parish. This includes the youth group, PSR, scouts, etc. No members are discerned for this group.

**The Outreach Committee** Plans and manages various outreach events as a way of serving the larger community, especially those most in need. Kate Schmitt, Lois Anderson, Susan Rettig & Eileen Messer are current members and cannot be nominated. Meets 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of the month at 6:30pm. **Three members needed plus one alternate.**
